ReBuairtel to Dallas dated 5/31/66.

On 5/31/66, Inspector REX SCHRODER, SOG, telephonically called the attention of the Dallas Office to article appearing in the Washington Post newspaper on 5/29/66 and requested that in the event Dallas could locate any information which would assist the Bureau in a rebuttal of the allegation contained in the article, it would be appreciated.

On 6/2/66, telephonic contact with Inspector SCHRODER indicated that the Bureau was desirous of any information Dallas had in its files with respect to a subsequent official autopsy report reflecting that the bullet which entered the shoulder of President KENNEDY had exited through his throat. He indicated further that in the event the Dallas Office had any such information to also determine if there was any indication that a member of the KENNEDY family had requested that the subsequent autopsy report be held in the strictist confidence.

Inspector SCHRODER was advised that such information was never received by Dallas.
