MARGUERITE CLAVERIE OSWALD

On November 28, 1966, Inspector Jack Hutton, Chief, Investigation Division, San Antonio Police Department, San Antonio, Texas, advised a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that his department had received information that Mrs. Marguerite Oswald, mother of deceased Lee Harvey Oswald, the assassin of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy, was scheduled to appear on the Allen Dale Program, Station WOAI-TV, on Wednesday, November 30, 1966.

Dale has a TV program from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM., each day on Station WOAI-TV, called "The Talk of San Antonio."

According to Inspector Hutton, Mrs. Oswald was scheduled to arrive on Braniff Airlines Flight No. 55 at 3:17 PM., November 29, 1966, at San Antonio, Texas, and was to be met at the Airport by Allen Dale. She reportedly has reservations at the El Tropicano Hotel in San Antonio and the length of her stay was not known.

At 11:28 AM, November 29, 1966, Special Agent William H. Patterson, U. S. Secret Service, Dallas, Texas, was advised of the foregoing information.
