I, Hoddon Spurgeon Aiken, hereby freely and voluntarily make the following statement to E. J. Robertson who has identified himself as a Special Agent of the F. B. I.

My name is Hoddon Spurgeon Aiken and I reside at 302 South Houston Street, Dallas, Texas. I am 69 years of age, born September 3, 1894, at Lipan, Texas. I am a white male and am employed as a warehouseman for Texas School Book Depository.

At the time President Kennedy was shot I was at the Texas School Book Depository warehouse located at 1917 North Houston Street, Dallas, Texas. I was with Franklin Wester who also works at this warehouse at the time the President was shot.

I did not see Lee Harvey Oswald at the time President Kennedy was shot. At no time on November 22, 1963, H.S.
