I, Mrs. Mary Sue Dickerson,
make the following voluntary
statement to Es R. Mill Crigley,
who has identified himself to me
as a Special Agent of the
Federal Bureau of Investigation.

I reside at 7310 Pries-
field Drive, Dallas, Texas,
and am employed with
Allyn and Bacon, Inc., room
301, Texas School Book
Depository, Dallas, Texas.

I am a white female
and I was born November
3, 1931. My husband is
Albert D. Dickerson.

On November 22, 1963, at
the time President John F.
Kennedy was assassinated
I was standing at the
curb on the north side
of Elm Street about equal
distance between the point
of

Id where the President was shot and the west end of the Texas School Book Depository building. I was with Mrs. Billie Clay, who is also employed with Allyn and Bacon, Inc. Mrs. Clay was on my right as best I can recall.

I did not see Lee Harvey Oswald on November 22, 1963, and I did not observe any strangers in the Texas School Book Depository building on the morning of November 22, 1963.

I returned to the building within five minutes after the shooting and left the building about two p.m. on November 22, 1963. Id
