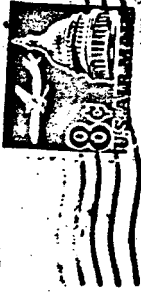



As of Nov 22, 1963, President John F. Kennedy was assassinated in the proximity of your building, and probably by rifle fire from a window in the building. It is therefore assumed that, books and records were a part of the assassination.

this case and is also insane.

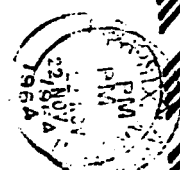
Also a Mr. Clark Armstrong
