

AGREEMENT TO REPLY ON BEHALF OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT

I, **Earl Perry Smith**, upon receipt of transportation tickets for myself, my wife, and my daughter for transportation from Boston to New York, purchased on my behalf by the American Embassy, Moscow, do hereby agree to repay without interest to the Treasurer of the United States upon demand, in legal tender of the United States, the cost of these tickets, when the contribution which I made toward their cost.

The cost of the transportation is as follows:

- (1) **Passenger tickets - Boston-New York** - \$12.00
(\$6.00 per adult, \$6.00 for child)
- (2) **Rail tickets - Moscow-New York** - \$15.00
(\$7.50 per adult)

I have contributed 20 rubles toward the price of the rail tickets, which is equivalent to \$15 plus \$1.71, the dollar equivalent of 15.71 rubles, making a total of \$31.71.

I understand that my obligation to repay the cost herein stated will not be discharged until the Treasurer of the United States actually receives in legal tender of the United States full repayment of that cost.

I further understand and agree that after my repatriation I will not be furnished a passport for travel abroad until my obligation to reimburse the Treasurer of the United States is liquidated.

Payment of the amount of this loan may be obtained by the Department of State from any source now or hereafter due to from the Veterans Administration or other agency of the United States Government.
