ABOUT 12:31 P.M. Nov 22, 1963, Pres. John F. KENNEDY AND Col. John Connally WERE SHOT WHILE RIDING IN PARADE IN THE 400 BLOCK OF ELM STREET NEARBY WEST. SHOTS WERE FIRED FROM SOUTHEAST FRONT WINDOW, TOP FLOOR OF TEXAS School Book DEPOSITORY AT 411 ELM STREET, Dallas. Rifle AND (1) ONE LIVE SHOT IN CHAMBER AND (3) THREE EMPTY SHELLS WERE FOUND IN BUILDING.

AT 11 PM Nov 22, 1963. A citizen Reported over the Police Radio That an OFFICER Had Been Shot IN FRONT OF 404 West 10th St. Dallas, Texas. This WAS PATROLMAN J. D. Tippitt, Dallas Police Dept. AT 3:55 PM Nov. 22, 1963 I ISSUED SEARCH WARRANT No. SW-295 THE STATE OF TEXAS VS A.C. JOHNSON AND OTHER UNKNOWN PERSONS 1026 N. BECKLEY AVE. DALLAS, TEXAS TO J.E. BILL DECKER + C.C. GENTRY Dallas Sheriff's Dept. A SEARCH WAS MADE BY Lt. E.L. CUNNINGHAM, Det F.M. TURNER, WALTER R. BUTTS, H.M. MOORE, B.L. SHANKS OF THE Dallas Police Dept AND ASST D.A. WILLIAM F. ALEXANDER AND MYSELF. ALL FURNITURES REMOVED FROM THE ROOM OF O.H. LAC (LAC HARVEY OSWALD) WERE TAKEN TO HOMICIDE BUREAU, DALLAS POLICE DEPT. THIS SEARCH WAS MADE ABOUT 4:30 PM Nov. 22, 1963. Warrant Returned + Filed Nov. 27, 1963 AT 4:00 PM.

AT 2:05 PM Nov. 22, 1963 THE SUSPECT LEE HARVEY OSWALD WAS CHARGED IN CASE NO. F-153 MURDER WITH MANNER OF J.D. TIPPITT. WARRANT WAS ISSUED TO CAPT. J.W. FITZ Dallas Police Dept. AND THE DEFENDANT WAS ARRAIGNED AT 7:00 PM. BY READING HIM THE ACCUSATION, ADVISING him HE DID NOT HAVE TO MAKE ANY STATEMENT, BUT THAT ANY STATEMENT HE MADE MIGHT BE USED AGAINST him FOR THE CHARGES STATED AND THAT HE WOULD BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO CONTACT HIS ATTORNEY AND DENIED BOND ON CAPITAL OFFENSE. Remanded to the Custody of the Sheriff of DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS.

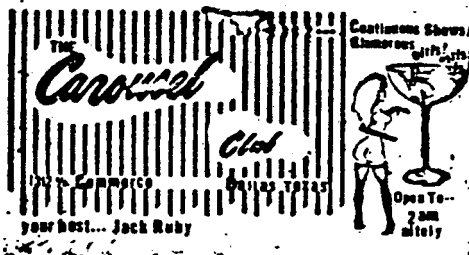
AT 11:26 PM Nov. 22, 1963 THE SUSPECT LEE HARVEY OSWALD WAS CHARGED IN CASE NO. F-154 MURDER WITH MANNER OF JOHN F. KENNEDY. WARRANT WAS ISSUED TO CAPT. J.W. FITZ Dallas Police Dept. THE DEFENDANT WAS TAKEN ABOUT 11:00 PM Nov. 22, 1963 TAKEN TO THE DETENTION ROOM IN THE REAR PART OF THE POLICE BLDG. WHERE THE PRESS WAS ALLOWED TO INTERVIEW THE DEFENDANT FOR ABOUT 6 HOURS. HE WAS THEN REMOVED BACK INTO THE JAIL BY HOMICIDE DETECTIVES.

Between 12:30 AM + 1:30 AM Nov. 23rd, 1963 MR. JACK RUBY WALKED UP TO ME AND GAVE ME HIS CARD AND INTRODUCED HIMSELF TO ME. I HAD SEEN HIM STANDING IN THE DETAIL ROOM W.H.O. THE PRESS INTERVIEWED THE DEFENDANT ATTACHED IS THE CARD GIVEN ME



AT 1:35 AM Nov 23rd, 1963 AT THE REQUEST OF DISTRICT ATTORNEY HENRY WADE I ARRAIGNED THE DEFENDANT LEE HARVEY OSWALD IN CASE NO H-154. THE AFFIDAVIT WAS READ TO THE DEFENDANT AS BEFORE AND HE WAS APTLY ADVISED OF HIS CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS. BOND WAS DENIED AS BEFORE AND THE DEFENDANT REMAINED AS BEFORE.

FROM ABOUT 1:45 AM UNTIL 3:45 AM I WAS IN CONFERENCE WITH DALLAS POLICE OFFICERS, D.A. HENRY WADE AND TWO OF HIS ASSISTANTS. I WENT HOME ABOUT 4 AM H-23-63

AT 6:15 AM Nov. 23rd, 1963 Lt. Robert E. McKinney, Dallas Police Dept. Filed Charges OF ASSAULT TO MURDER OF JOHN B. CONNALLY IN CASE NO. F-155 AGAINST LEE HARVEY OSWALD. WARRANT WAS ISSUED TO LT. MCKINNEY AND THE DEFENDANT WAS NOT ARRAIGNED OR PRESENT WHEN THE CHARGE WAS FILED.

ABOUT 11:20 AM Nov. 24th, 1963 The Defendant Lee Harvey Oswald while being transported from the basement of the Police Bldg to Dallas County Jail WAS SHOT BY JACK RUBY, a white male. OSWALD WAS TAKEN BY ONEAL, INC. Ambulance to PARKLAND MEMORIAL HOSP. where he EXPIRED AT 1:07 PM (1307) Nov. 24th, 1963 IN SURGERY. Justice of the Peace PIERCE HEBBARD, Precinct 1 Prec 2 HELD AN INQUEST AND ORDERED A MEDICO-LEGAL autopsy which was done by DR. EARL K. ROSE, M.D. AT PARKLAND MEMORIAL HOSPITAL. A CHARGE OF MURDER WITH MALICE WAS FILED ON JACK RUBY BY P.A. HENRY WADE WITH JUDGE HEBBARD.

To my knowledge ALL EVIDENCE WAS GATHERED BY THE DALLAS POLICE DEPT., THEIR CRIME LAB. OFFICERS HANDLED THESE ITEMS FOR PROCESS. ALL OTHER POLICE AGENCIES TURNED THEIR INFORMATIONS OVER TO THE DALLAS POLICE DEPT.
