TOY has eleared the attached letter to Mr. Farrell, Commissioner Incigration and Enturalization, and the telegram to Hoscow about the Lumigrant wise case of Mrs. Marine M. Oswald. In considering this ex I believe it would be helpful for you to have the following additional information. It refors to the scound paragraph of YO's accordadus relative to Mr. Oswald's statements that he intended to reveal information to Seviet authorities about his work as radio operator in the Marine Corps. Oswald entermed at the Poscow Schesty on July 8 on his own initiative in connection with his desire to return to the United States with his wife. He was questioned at length concerning his activities since entering the Soviet union. There is quoted below the applicable personant from labeauty despetch No. 29 of July 21, 1961: . "Urwald stated that he had never been called upon to make any statements for radio or press or to oddress audiences since his arrival in the Soviet Union and that he has made no statements at any time of any exploitable nature concerning his eriginal decision to reside in the Soviet Unioc. He recalled that he had been interviewed briefly in his room at the Setropole Hotel in Koscow on the third day after his arrival in the Soviet Union by a reporter from Tadio Poscow. The reporter represented bimself as seeking convents from Azerican tourists . on their impressions of Foscov. Orwald stated that he made to sore than a few routine exements of a visiting tourist nature, the whole lasting no nore than two or three minutes and of no political significance. When queried about a statement which he had made to the interviewing officer at the time of his first apparence at the babassy on October II, 1959, to the effect that he would willingly make available to the Soviet Union such information as he had acquired as a radar operator i the Merine Corps, Oswald stated that he was never in fact subconcerning his life or experiences prior to ontering the Soviet Union, and never provided such information to my Soviet organ-Be stated that he doubted in fact that he would have given such information if requested despite his statements made at the Babasay."
