DAILY DRESSY MEETING  
Oct. 31, 1959.

1200 arrive in "BOLSHAKOV TAXI", two Russian policemen come  
 at the embassy, one asks me I approach entrance of the  
 embassy and says "WELCOME". I smile and wave my hand.  
 He motions me to pass inside with them. Their car is with  
 Don't sit back in his mind that it is a Russian. When I get  
 to the 2nd floor and non-decision button down shirt etc.  
 Entering I find the office of consular vice consul

 rises and taking my passport goes into the other  
 office where she lays the passport on a table desk. saying  
 "There is a small room outside, she says please to discuss  
 U.S. citizenship." On "Thank you" says, "Thanks" he says to the  
 girl without looking up from his typing. She, as she comes  
 out, invites me into the inner office to sit down. I do  
 so, selecting my perch on the front left side of  
 SNYDER'S chair (it was 5:00 when I took the road car)  
 I wait, crossing my legs and looking my watch in my lap.  
 He finishes typing. He reads the letter from his typewriter  
 and expressing his wishes etc. etc.  
 "What can I do for you?" I say, "I want to know  
 "Is there to discuss my U.S. citizenship and would like  
 to sign the legal papers for that?" "Do you have any  
 for American citizenship?" yes. He takes out a pile of papers  
 and says "I want you to read this and give me some information  
 on the same, personal information to what I want to know:  
 "YOUR HISTORY AND EDUCATION" I say I have graduated high school  
 etc. American history etc. American imperialism, I say  
 Marxist, and I say I want to know for that I want to live  
 in the U.S. or be a citizen of American citizenship he says  
 OK. THAT'S ALL YOU WANT TO KNOW? YOU WANT TO SIGN  
 YOU WANT TO. I said "I REQUEST THAT I BE ALLOWED TO SIGN LEGAL  
 PAPERS. I WANT TO SIGN OF AMERICAN CITIZENSHIP. YOU REPRESENT THE U.S.  
 HE SAYS "OK" BUT THE OTHER SIDE HAS TO GET  
 in the meantime, where can I... I say "I want to know  
 I want to know if I can sign the legal papers for that?"  
 he says "I will try to get that for you."
