Dear Mr. Oswald:

I refer to your letter of December 1, 1961, in which you raise a question regarding your application for an exit wise and your Soviet documentation.

It is the Embassy's view that, since you are not considered a Societ citisen by the authorities in this country, you are entitled to receive a Soviet exit visa upon presentation of a valid foreign mational passport. Regarding the latter, as we have indicated to you before, we can take up the matter of renewing your expired American passport upon your mext personal appearance at the Embassy.

It further appears to us that your right to an exit wise will not be affected by your acceptance of an extension of your present Soviet documentation, which is after all, prime facie evidence that you are not regarded here as a Soviet citisen.

If you intend to press your own individual application for a Soviet exit visa and are prepared to depart as soon as you receive it, I suggest that you come to this Embassy at your earliest opportunity to see about renewal of your expired American passports
