LETTER TAKEN

I, the Honary Consul, do hereby  
report the enclosed United States  
citizenship to be accepted.

I signed in person, at the consular  
office of the United States Embassy, Moscow,  
on Oct 31st, for the purpose of signing  
the form of papers to this effect. This  
high right I was refused at that time.

I wish to protest against this action,  
and against the conduct of the officials of  
the United States consular service who  
acted on behalf of the United States  
government.

My application, requesting that I  
be considered for citizenship in the  
United States is now pending before  
the Supreme Soviet of the U.S.S.R..

In the event of acceptance, I will  
request my government to lodge a  
formal protest regarding this incident.
