received a reply to my letter of December 1960, I am writing again asking that you consider my request for the return of my American passport.

I desire to return to the United States, that is if we could come to some agreement concerning the dropping of my legal proceedings against me. If no, then I would be free to ask the Russian authorities to allow me to leave. If I could show them my American passport, I am of the opinion they would give me an exit visa. They have of the time insisted that I take Russian citizenship. I am living here

with non-payment Type passes
for a foreigner.

I cannot leave Brazil
without permission, therefore I
am writing with the same calling
as usual.

I hope that in meeting
the responsibility I have to
America that you remember
you're not doing everything
you can to help the cause
I am an American citizen.

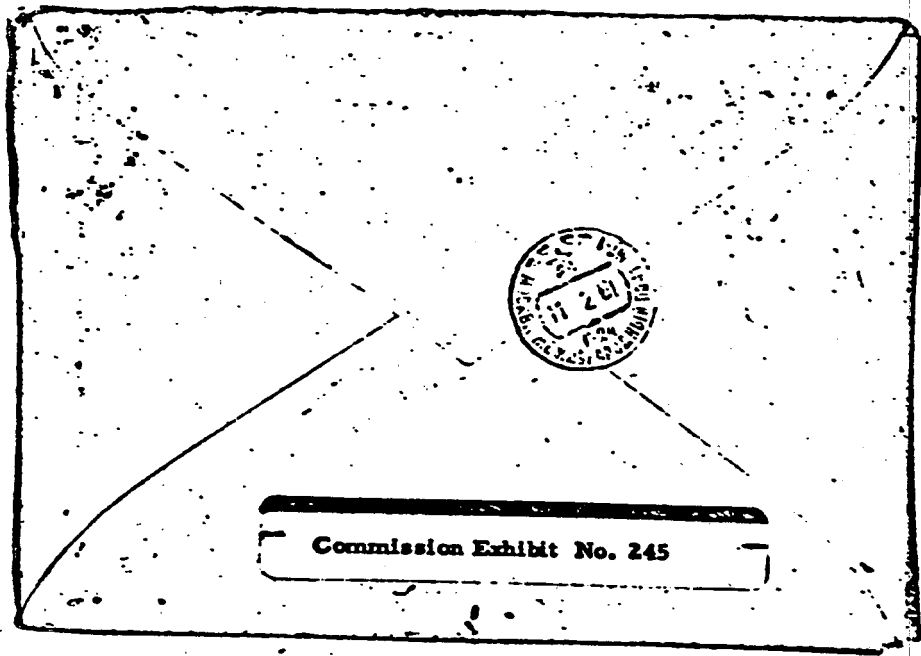
