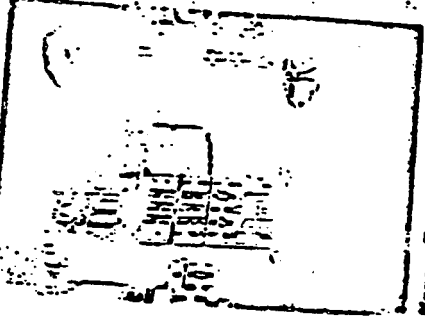

Dear Edith,

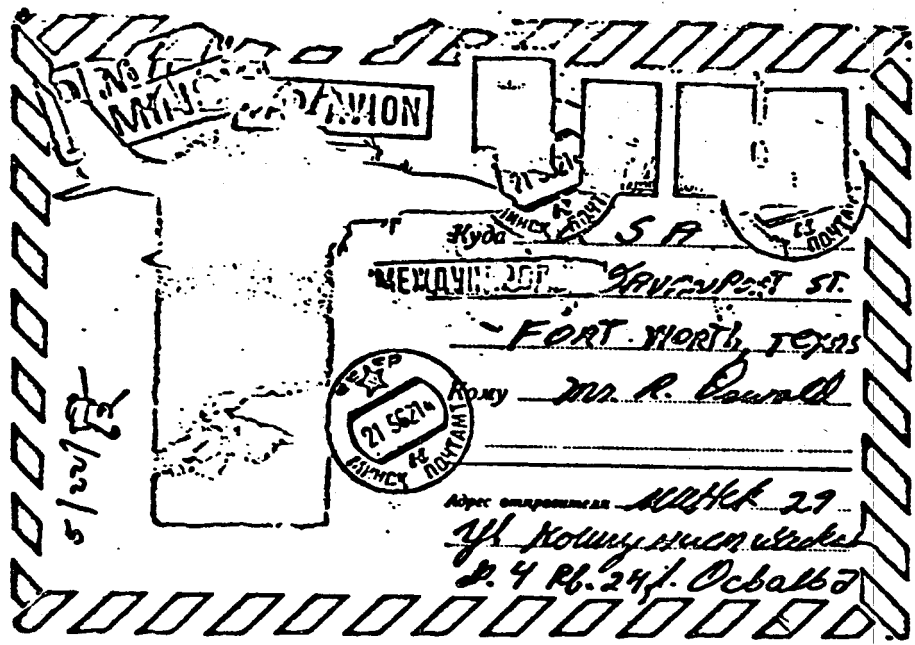
