On November 22, 1963 I was present and accompaning Identenant Jack Revill in the basement of the City of Dallas, City Hall located at 2000 Hain Street. Identenant Revill and myself along with several other Officers had just completed searching the Taxas School-Book Depository from which Lee Harvey Osmald assasinated the President of the United States, Identenant Revill and myself were enroute to the Special Service Bureau Office.

Upon entering the basement of the City Hall Lieutenant Revill and myself met Federal Bureau of Investigation Agent Hosty who had already parked his our and was walking very fast toward the entrance of the City Hall from the parking area. At this time Agent Hesty made the statement that Lee Oswald had killed the President and that Oswald was a Communist. Bosty also said that he knew that Oswald was a Communist and that he knew Oswald was working at the School Book Depository.

While we were in the basement Hosty also said several things to Lieutenent Revill that I scald not hear as there was a lot of excitment and commotion there.

Liceutement Revill and myself them accompanied Misty to Captain Prits's office and Liceutement Revill introduced Hosty to Liceutement Red Wells. We, Liceutement Revill and myself them went to the Special Service Bureau Office where Liceutement Revill made a Report of the incident and turned the report into Captain W. F. Germanny who is in Charge.
