WELFARE-WHEREABOUTS: Lee Barvey Oswa Embassy's despatch 23h dated November 2, 1959 The Embassy has had no contact with Oswald since his departure from the Metropole Rotel in Moscow in November, 1959, and has no clew as to his present whereabouts. The Embassy has no evidence that Oswald has expatriated himself other than his amounced intention to do so, and the Embassy is, therefore, technically in a position to institute an inquiry concerning his thereabouts through a note to the Foreign Office. We believe, however, that there might be less utility in such an approach than if the Embassy were to transmit to the Foreign Kinistry, in connection with a formal inquiry or simply alone, a personal letter to Oswald from his mother with the request that it be forwarded to Oswald.
