SUBJECT: CHTIZE:SHIP AND PASSPORTS: Lee Harvey Oswald

to: The American Enbassy MDSDU

Further study has been given to the case of Mr. Oswald in the light of the E-bassy's Despatch No. 806 of May 26, 1961.

Hr. Oswald's nother has been informed to the effect that her son has not yet visited the Debasey and that he has informed the Debasey that he has narried a Russian tourn.

The Department concurs with the Bibasay in its proposed reply to Ir. Osmid, as indicated in the second paragraph of Do _ such 25.606.

It is noted that while im. Osmald is in possession of a Soviet internal passport he apparently is designated therein as whithout citizenship." It is not entirely clear that this designation is intended to infer, i.e. whether he is without Soviet citizenship or without any citizenship. In any eremt in the absence of evidence showing that Ir. Countains definitely lost United States citions he apparently maintains that technical status. Thether he is autifule to the protection of the United States pending any further developments concerning his precise status is a matter thich will be left to the Dubessy's discribion in the event an energency sibuation should trise. In a situation of this kind, not of an energency nature, the facts should be submitted to the Department.

It is noted that the Dibassy intends to seek the Department's prior advice before granting Mr. Osmild documentation as a United States citizen upon any application he may subsite.

The Embassy's careful attention to the involved onse of Hr. Oswald is appreciated. It is assumed that there is no doubt that the porson who has been in communication with the Ambassy is the person who was issued a passport in the mane of Los Harvey Osweid.
