In connection with the interviews of WALTER KIRK GOLDMAN, 4338 Newton, Dallas, on 6/3 and 4/64, symbols on photograph identified as follows:

- "A" - is place where 1950 white or beige Ford first observed by GOLDMAN;
- "B" - is place where 1958 black over white, Buick Chevrolet first observed by GOLDMAN;
- "C" - is alley entrance into Morrison Church parking lot, and which alley entrance is obscured from GOLDMAN's vision due to steakade fence around garbage cans.
- "1" - is place where unknown white male, No. 1, first observed by GOLDMAN.
- "2" - is place where unknown white male, No. 2, first observed by GOLDMAN.
- "3" - is GOLDMAN's position for observing incidents at 4/10/63, from behind steakade fence.
