Mr. SLAWSON volunteered that OSWALD's wife had first prevaricated that she knew nothing about OSWALD's trip to Mexico, but subsequently she advised that she knew that he was in Mexico for the purpose of making a trip to Cuba. He stated that this information was confidential and that it was not to be disseminated to anyone.

He advised also that OSWALD's wife had admitted that upon OSWALD's return from Mexico he told her that he had attended a bullfight and had visited "some museums."

Therefore, the Commission has disallowed the possibility that OSWALD visited a Jai Lai game and it was Mr. SLAWSON's opinion that, since an individual has to be properly dressed to attend a Jai Lai game, OSWALD, in his attire, would not have gone there.
