

Mexico Continues Probe of JFK Assa.

Federal police yesterday were reported to be cooperating with agents of New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison in reopening the investigation of the visit to Mexico City by Lee Harvey Oswald.

The reports, however, could not be confirmed.

Garrison has said in New Orleans he is convinced Oswald was involved in a conspiracy to assassinate President John F. Kennedy. Oswald is known to have visited Mexico City in the fall of 1963.

Investigators are said to be questioning several per-

sons who allegedly met with Oswald while he was here. Federal police are understood to have the names of 14 such persons.

Oswald came here by bus shortly after his appearance in New Orleans ostensibly as a member of the pro-Castro "Fair Play for Cuba"

committee.
