Reverend FRED B. ALLEN, Jr., 505 Oklahema Avenue, advised he is paster of the North Glanged Baptist Church, Enoxville. He advised he and his parents. Mr. and Mrs. FRED B. ALLEN, Sr., 1400 North 4th Avenue, Knoxville, are long-time friends of JOHN HOWARD BOWEN, whom he described as an 84 year old missionary. Reverend ALLEN stated that BOWEN has worked as a missionary in Mexico for the past 22 years.

Reverend ALLEN advised be has not seen BOFFN for quite some time, but advised be had recently received a post-card from BOWEN postwarked 2/18/64 at San Antonio, Texas. He advised this was an airmail postcard of the type purchased at U. S. Post Offices. He said the only wosnage on the card was BOWEN'S new mailing address and that BOWEN hoped to hear from him soon. Reverend ALLEN stated the new address furnished by BOWFN has Niza 22, Mexico D.F.

Reverend ALLEN advised he had absolutely no idea as to BOWEN'S present whereabouts, but advised he would immediately noticy the Knewville FBI Office if he or his parents heard anything furthe: from EQUEN.

Mrs. BESSIF WHITE Vice President, Pisgah Home Movement, Pikeville, Tennessee, advised that she has known of JOHN HOWARD BOWEN for about the past four years. She stated she received information through some source, unrecelled at the present time, that BOWEN was a supervisor of a mission in Nexico. and she has been making contilutions to be used to support one of the Evangelists She said that BOWEN is a rep escutative of the Pentacostal or Full Gospel Church and that he reportedly has several Evangelists working under him at this mission that he operates. She said that the Evangelists are reportedly Mexicans and are working throughout Mexico.

She indicated that she contributes \$35.00 pe, month at the present time but originally only contributed \$25.00 per month. This money is supposed to be used to support one of the Evangelists and she receives a receipt each month for the person who received the money. The money is sent to POWEN, who in turn makes the money available to the Evangelist. FOWIN also furnishes a receipt indicating that be receives the money that she contributes. She stated that she makes the contribution in the form of bank drafts, which are drawn on the litet Mational Bank of Pikeville, Pikeville Tennessee, and these deafts are made payrile to BOWEN. She said that these cancelled bank drafts, as well as the receipts, are presently in her possession. She said that she has received information that other persons were contributing to this same cause, but she did not know the identity of any of these persons. She said that BOWEN has never solicited any contributions from bor, however, he did notify he. They the cost of supporting one of the Evangelist had increased from \$25.00 to 335.00 per month. She has never seen BOWEN and her only contar has been through the United States mails by letter.

She said that she knew very little about BOWEN but he has advised her in his letters that he is originally from Knoxville, Tennessee. She does not know any thing about his background but understands that he has been in Mexico for about 18 years doing missionary work. In addition to the money sent each month, the Piegah Home Mission occasionally sends used clothing and other articles to BOWEN to be distributed to the needy.

She said that the only name she ever onew this person by was JOHN HOW RD BOWEN and his last address was Kiza 22. Mexico,
