RE OSWALD'S MODE OF DEPARTURE FROM MEXICO. LHM REPORTING THIS PHASE OF INVESTIGATION SUBMITTED APRIL 7 WITHOUT TABLE OF CONTENTS. ALTHOUGH 40 PAGES IN LENGTH, NOT KNOWN IF BUREAU WOULD HANDLE EIGHT PHOTOGRAPHIC EXHIBIT PAGES AS INTEGRAL PART THEREOF AS SUBMITTED. AFTER BUREAU HAS REVIEWED LHM REQUEST INSTRUCTIONS AS TO WHETHER OR NOT TABLE OF CONTENTS DESIRED FOR FIRST 32 PAGES OR ENTIRE LHM AS SUBMITTED.

RE OSWALD'S TRAVEL TO MEXICO. INVESTIGATION TO LOCATE PASSENGER LISTS FOR RED ARROW BUS OF SEPTEMBER 26 LAST FROM MAIN OFFICES HERE NEGATIVE BUT OFFICIALS OF COMPANY HAVE AGREED TO PERMIT BUREAU AGENTS TO SEARCH RECORDS FOR THOSE LISTS AND LISTS OF PASSENGERS WHO MAY HAVE EMBARKED SAME BUS AT INTERMEDIATE POINTS.

RE OSWALD'S DEPARTURE FROM MEXICO. PHOTOGRAPHS OF PHILIPPE PITER E. VAN DER VORM BEING SUBMITTED APRIL 9 NEXT WITH REQUEST SAN ANTONIO OFFICE BE FURNISHED COPIES TO EXHIBIT TO AGAPITO DEL RIO.
