LEE HARVEY OSWALD

On March 31, 1964, HARVEY CASH, American Consul,
Nuevo Laredo, Mexico, advised that the official name and
title for the Chief of Mexican Immigration is GILBERTO
GARZA, Jefe de Poblacion, Nuevo Laredo, Mexico
(Chief of Mexican Immigration, Nuevo Laredo, Mexico) and
that all official mail and directives between Mexican
Immigration and the American Consulate, Nuevo Laredo,
reflect the name as GILBERTO CAZARES GARZA.

Mr. CASH stated that GILBERTO CAZARES GARZA
has been Chief of Mexican Immigration at Nuevo Laredo
for the past five years.

In the construction of Spanish names, CAZARES
is the name of the father, or first surname, and GARZA
is the maternal, or second surname, being the maiden name
of his mother.
