NOTE:

Commission indicated it received evidence Oswald had a picture taken in Mexico City on 9/27 or 28/63 for use on an application for a visa at the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City. Commission suggested photograph was probably taken at inexpensive photographic studio near the Cuban Embassy and requested Bureau attempt to locate where such photograph taken. We conducted extensive inquiry in eight-block radius of Cuban Embassy, in vicinity of hotel where Oswald stayed in Mexico City and in vicinity of a travel agency where Oswald purchased ticket to return to U. S. without locating studio of interest. We furnished results of our checks to the Commission by letter 6/11/64 and asked Commission, if it desired we extend our investigation to all Metropolitan Mexico City in effort to locate the studio concerned. Commission indicated such action not necessary and that our substantial efforts to locate such studio are sufficient.
