LEE HARVEY OSWALD, IS-R-CUBA  
 RE LOS ANGELES AIRTEL JUNE 11 LAST, SETTING FORTH RESULTS  
 OF INTERVIEW OF EULALIO RODRIGUEZ CHAVEZ WHO POSITIVELY  
 IDENTIFIED OSWALD AS PASSENGER ON TRANSPORTES DEL NORTE BUS.

RODRIGUEZ IN INTERVIEW MENTIONED YOUNG MARRIED WOMAN  
 OF MEXICAN DESCENT WHO TRAVELED FROM MEXICO CITY TO HOUSTON  
 WHERE SHE INDICATED SHE RESIDED. IT IS SUGGESTED THIS WOMAN  
 WOULD HAVE TO BE IDENTICAL WITH EITHER PAULA RUSIONA OR MISS  
COSIO, THE ONLY TWO WOMEN BOARDING BUS IN MEXICO CITY WHO  
 HAVE NOT BEEN FULLY IDENTIFIED, OR HILDA QUEZADA WHO BOARDED  
 BUS AT SAN LUIS POTOSI.

IF NOT ALREADY DONE, SUGGEST HOUSTON BE INSTRUCTED TO  
 ENDEAVOR TO DETERMINE WHETHER WOMAN MENTIONED BY RODRIGUEZ,  
 POSSIBLY IDENTICAL WITH ONE OF THREE WOMEN MENTIONED ABOVE.
