The indices were reviewed covering all current employees and all former employees who had terminated from 1/1/60 to date.
The search was not limited to waiters but covered all persons who had the first name of RAUL (RAOUL). There were no persons with the name of RAOUL. The personnel files on all the individuals with the first name of RAUL were pulled for background information. The records covering the vacation periods of the RAULs were examined and some interviews were conducted.

The only RAUL (LNU) who seemed to be similar to the individual whom we are trying to locate was a bus boy by the name of RAUL RODRIGUEZ WONG:

RAUL/RODRIGUEZ WONG was generally known as RAUL WONG. He is described as follows:

Waiters and Bus Boys Union, 321 South Bixer Street, Lor Angeles, advised on 6/24/64 that RAUL WONG had withdrawn from active membership in the union on 6/2/64, stating that he was going to return to Mexico to live with his family for a number of months, and when he returned to Los Angeles would again become an active member of the union. According to the union records, his last address was 223 South Brand Boulevard, Glendale, California. His last employment was at the Beverly Rodeo Hotel as a bus boy in the Chez Voltaire Room.

the Brand Hotel, 223½ South Brand Boulevard, Glendale, advised on 5/24/5% that she had been manager of this hotel since 6/1/63 and that RAUL WONG had not lived there since that time. However, numerous pieces of mail have been addressed to WONG at this address and she had returned them to the post office with the notation that he no longer resided at that address and that she had no forwarding address for him. She stated that all of her guests were transients. This hotel is located all in one floor above small stores.

Mrs. ETHEL S. HEYER, in charge of Liaison and Records at INS, Los Angeles, advised on 6/24/64 that INS, Los Angeles, had no record of a RAUL WONG or RAUL RODRIGUEZ WONG.

the Beverly Rodeo Hotel, 360 North Rodeo Drive, Beverly Hills, advised on 6/24/64 that RAVIA WONG worked at the hotel as a bus boy until the latter part of May, 1964, when he quit, advising that he was going home to

personnel records for the Beverly Rodeo Hotel. This hotel is run by the Republic Construction Company, 9201 Wilshire Boulevard, Beverly Hills. On 6/24/64 she advised that RAUL R. WONG had last been employed by the Beverly Rodeo Hotel from 12/13/63 to 5/20/64. His last address was 1455 North Logan Street, Los Angeles. He was employed as a bus boy.

On 6/24/64 135 South Hope Street was observed and it is now non existent, all buildings having been razed as a result of the Bunker Hill Urban Renewal Program which has been going on for the past two years.

is not related to WONG. Several years ago perated a rooming house on South Hope Street and at that time WONG was a roomer from time to time dowing the time that he lived in Los Angeles. Subsequently, moved to her current address and WONG helped her move. At different times during the past two years he has resided at her address and has used it as a mailing address; however, he has not lived there during 1964.

WONG's father is Chinese and his mother, whose maidage name is RODRIGUEZ, is a Mexican. WONG is one of five children. WONG's family is well known in Chihuahua, Chihuahua, Mckico. WONG's wife is EMELIA GONZALES. She believes that WONG has about four children.

During the time that she has known RAUL WONG, he has made a number of trips from Los Angeles to Chihuahua. He normally enters and leaves the United States through El Paso. She believes that he has some friends in El Paso. She could not recall that he has any relatives in El Paso.

In May, 1964, RAUL WONG visited her and stated that he had quit his job at the Beverly Hills Hotel and was going to return home and live with his family in Chinushua, Chinushua.

WONG always represented himself to her as a waiter and did not mention that he was merely a bus boy. To the best of her knowledge, WONG is still residing in Chihuahua, Chihuahua, Mexico. She has not heard from him during the month of June, 1964.

It should be noted that RAUL WONG terminated his Beverly Hilton employment on 8/29/63 and left to visit his mother. His next employment in this area was when he was rehired on 12/13/63 by the Beverly Rodeo Hotel. From these records it would appear that it was possible for him to have been in Chihuahua, Chihuahua, in November, 1963.

No further investigation is being conducted by Los Angeles on the other RAULs, UACB. No report is being submitted UACB because this is an administrative matter to identify a RAUL (LNU).

In view of the fact that RAUL RODRIGUEZ WONG appears to be the individual from Chihuahua, Chihuahua, Mexico, it is requested that the Bureau give consideration that he be interviewed.
