ROLANDO BARRIOS, FORMER EMPLOYEE OF CHIHUAHUENSES TRAVEL AGENCY WAS INTERVIEWED ON APRIL 2 LAST BY SA ROLF L. LARSON AND WAS SHOWN PHOTOSTATS OF EXCHANGE ORDERS ON BASIS OF WHICH H. O. LEE PURCHASED TRANSPORTES DEL NORTE AND GREYHOUND TRANSPORTATION FROM MEXICO CITY TO DALLAS. HE ALSO WAS SHOWN PHOTOGRAPH OF OSWALD'S TOURIST CARD AND STATED HE WOULD INTERPRET THE COMMA FOLLOWING THE LEE TO INDICATE THE SURNAME TO BE LEE AND IN ORDER TO AVOID UNNECESSARY WRITING ON EXCHANGE ORDERS WOULD HAVE USED INITIALS OF FIRST AND MIDDLE NAMES WHICH HE CONSIDERED TO BE HARVEY OSWALD. HE COULD NOT RECALL SUBJECT OR DEALING WITH HIM BUT ON VIEWING ABOVE DOCUMENTS AFFIRMED THAT HE WOULD HAVE WRITTEN NAME AS H. O. LEE IF TAKING IT FROM TOURIST CARD.

ON BASIS OF ARRANGEMENT MADE AT THAT TIME BARRIOS STATED HE WOULD ATTEMPT TO RECONSTRUCT EVENTS IN EFFORT TO RECALL ADDITIONAL INFORMATION BUT CALLED SA LARSON TELEPHONICALLY ON APRIL 6 LAST TO ADVISE HE HAD BEEN UNABLE TO REMEMBER HIS CONTACT WITH OSWALD.
