During investigation of assassination of President Kennedy, CIA, Mexico, made available to Legat certain photos of unknown male taken outside the United States sometime between 7/1/63 and 11/23/63. Three of these photos, with background cropped out, were displayed to Gutierrez Valencia in Mexico during investigation of his allegation that he had seen Oswald on the premises of the Cuban Embassy in Mexico. Gutierrez Valencia stated the photos were not of the man he saw at the Embassy. The man in the photos had not been identified at the time of the Warren Commission report, and appears to have no pertinence whatsoever to the investigation. The photos shown Gutierrez Valencia were never made a part of the commission record.
