 THE NEAT TIPPIT HOME IN SOUTH DALLAS WAS EMPTY. MRS. TIPPIT
 TOOK THE CHILDREN TO VISIT RELATIVES IN CLARKSVILLE AND GREENVILLE
 IN EAST TEXAS FOR THE HOLIDAYS.
 IN THE LAST FEW DAYS, THE FLOW OF LETTERS TO DALLAS POLICE
 HEADQUARTERS FOR THE TIPPIT FUND HAS SLOWED. THE END APPEARED NEAR.
 UNLESS THE PACE QUICKENS AGAIN, POLICE SHOULD BE FINISHED COUNTING
 NEXT MONTH. DISPOSITION OF THE MONEY WILL TAKE LONGER.
