**Independent Test  
 Made on Bullets  
 In Assassination**

PHILADELPHIA, April 6 (AP).—The bullets used to kill President Kennedy were tested in the Philadelphia crime laboratory, officials say.

Dr. Edward J. Burke, director of the policy laboratory, said the tests were made March 24 and 25 by Joseph Nicol, superintendent of the Illinois Bureau of Criminal Investigation and Identification.

Dr. Burke said Chief Justice Earl Warren wanted an independent check run on tests by the FBI, and Mr. Nicol was selected to make them.

Mr. Nicol testified before the Warren Commission, investigating the deaths of Mr. Kennedy and Lee Harvey Oswald, April 1. He said he would not discuss his testimony until the commission makes a report on its investigation.
