DALLAS, Nov. 21 (AP).—An amateur photographer, who decided after nearly a year the photo-finisher's opinion might be wrong, turned up at the Associated Press office yesterday with a dramatic picture taken minutes after President Kennedy was shot last Nov. 22.

Justin Newman, a student at nearby Arlington State College, took the picture with an inexpensive box camera as the automobile bearing the wounded President sped to Parkland Hospital.

"I took the film to a drug store and then sent it to the photo finisher. When I got the film back about ten days later they said they didn't print my pictures because they were blurred," Mr. Newman told AP night wirephoto editor Carl Linde.

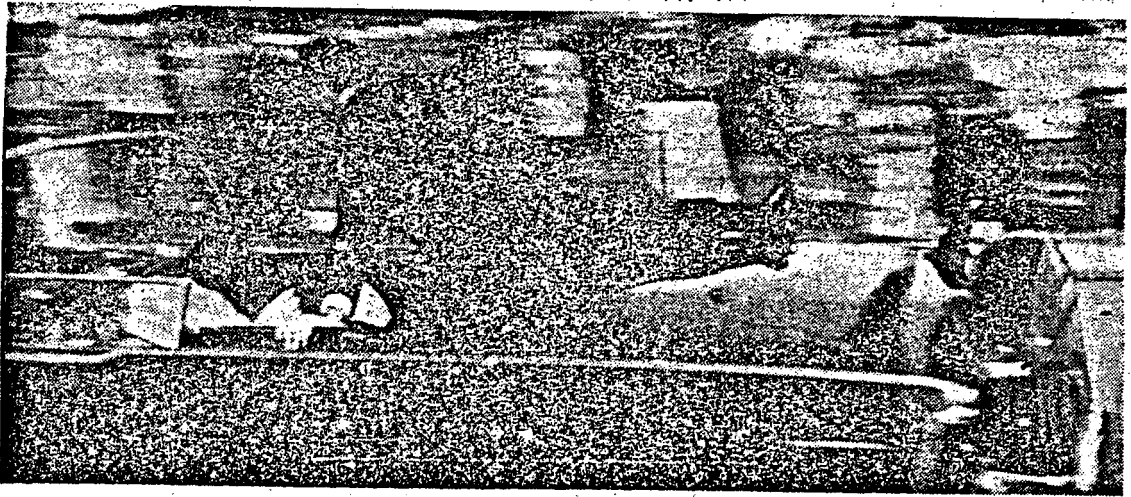
"But today I got curious about the negatives and had a friend make some prints for me. When I saw this picture I decided to call you."
