**Oswald's Rifle**

The Justice Department is expected to seek legislation giving the United States ownership of the rifle that killed President Kennedy, United Press International reported. The proposed legislation would permit the Attorney General to pick any items accepted as evidence by the Warren Commission and turn them over to the National Archives.

Lee Harvey Oswald's widow is legal owner of the rifle, although it is now being held by the FBI. Mrs. Oswald said recently she was offered \$10,000 for the rifle and the pistol used to kill Dallas policeman J. D. Tippit.
