Lane to Write Play on Trial Of Oswald

OXFORD, England, Aug. 20
A theater company here has commissioned American lawyer and Warren report critic Mark Lane to write a play depicting Lee Harvey Oswald on trial.

It will aim to show that on the Warren Commission's evidence Oswald stood a good chance of getting off any charges of killing President Kennedy, a theater spokesman said today.

Frank Hauser, a director of the Oxford Playhouse Theater, said the two-part play would set out available prosecution evidence and the defense that could be raised against it.

The prosecution case would be entirely from the Warren Commission report, with tape recordings and film excerpts. The defense would dramatize the confusion and contradiction a lawyer might have brought up on Oswald's behalf, Hauser said.
