 ADD 1 COMMISSION, WASHINGTON
 THE PHOTOGRAPHS WERE NEVER SEEN BY THE WARREN COMMISSION, A JUSTICE DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID. THREE PATHOLOGISTS HAD BASED THEIR PRESENTATION TO THE WARREN COMMISSION ON THE PHOTOGRAPHS AND THEIR OWN OBSERVATIONS.

TWO OF THE PATHOLOGISTS VERIFIED THE PICTURES TODAY. THOSE TWO WERE CAPT. J. J. HUMES AND DR. J. THORNTON BOSWELL. THE THIRD PATHOLOGIST, COL. PIERRE FINCK, IS IN VIET NAM.

THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT SAID IT HAD ASKED THE KENNEDY FAMILY TO DELIVER THE PICTURES AS PART OF THE "HISTORICAL RECORD" CONCERNING THE TRAGEDY. THE PICTURES WERE DESCRIBED AS "VERY BLOODY AND GRUESOME."

THE KENNEDY FAMILY EXECUTORS--MRS. JOHN F. KENNEDY, SEN. ROBERT F. KENNEDY, D-N.Y., AND SEN. EDWARD M. KENNEDY, D-MASS., OUTLINED THE RESTRICTIONS FOR THE VIEWING OF THE PICTURES IN A LETTER DRAFTED BY AN UNIDENTIFIED KENNEDY FAMILY LAWYER.

THOSE RESTRICTIONS WERE:

- OFFICIAL FEDERAL GOVERNMENT BODIES MAY VIEW THE PICTURES.
- PUBLIC DISPLAYS WILL BE PROHIBITED.
- FOR THE FIRST FIVE YEARS STARTING NOW NO NON-GOVERNMENTAL BODY WILL BE ALLOWED TO SEE THE PICTURES UNLESS AN EXCEPTION IS MADE BY THE KENNEDY FAMILY.

--AFTER FIVE YEARS ACCESS WILL BE LIMITED TO PATHOLOGISTS, OTHER MEDICAL EXPERTS AND INVESTIGATORS WITH A "SERIOUS PURPOSE."

THE BAN IS LIMITED TO THE LIFETIME OF MRS. KENNEDY, THE TWO PARENTS OF THE LATE PRESIDENT, HIS BROTHERS, SISTERS AND TWO CHILDREN.

THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT URGED THE KENNEDY FAMILY TO DELIVER THE HISTORIC PHOTOGRAPHS PARTLY, A SPOKESMAN SAID, IN ANSWER TO WRITTEN CRITICISM DEMANDING TO KNOW WHERE THEY WERE LOCATED.
