NEW ORLEANS--SEN. RUSSELL B. LONG, D-LA., SAID TODAY HE HAS "ALWAYS SUSPECTED" THERE WAS SOMEONE BESIDES LEE HARVEY OSWALD INVOLVED IN PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION.
