### Warren Unit Aide Sees New Probe As Waste of Time

NEW ORLEANS (AP)—A Tulane University law professor who served as a Warren Commission investigator says he believes a new probe of the assassination of President Kennedy would be a waste of time.

Leon D. Hubert Jr., former Orleans Parish district attorney, worked with the commission on conspiracy aspects of the assassination.

Hubert said yesterday he agreed with the findings of the commission on the death of the late president. Earlier yesterday, J. Edgar Hoover, director of the FBI, said all available evidence indicates Lee Harvey Oswald acted alone in the assassination.

Hubert said no link was found between Jack Ruby and Oswald. Ruby gunned down Oswald as police led him through a station basement. Hubert said he was convinced Ruby told the truth down the line about acting alone in the death of Oswald.
