 WARREN AND HIS WIFE ARE ON A PRIVATE TOUR OF LATIN AMERICA.
 RESPONDING GENTLY TO A BARRAGE OF QUESTIONS FROM NEWSMEN WHO
 FILLED THE AUDITORIUM IN THE U.S. EMBASSY, WARREN SAID HE DID NOT
 BELIEVE REVISION OF THE WARREN REPORT OR A NEW INVESTIGATION WAS
 WARRANTED ON THE BASIS OF THE PRESENT KNOWN FACTS.

THE PRESS CONFERENCE WAS A SCHEDULED PART OF WARREN'S TWO-DAY
 VISIT TO PERU, WHERE HE MET WITH PRESIDENT FERNANDO BELAUNDE TERRY.
 "NOBODY IS MORE INTERESTED IN TRUTH THAN MYSELF. NOBODY
 SHOULD BE AFRAID OF THE TRUTH," WARREN RESPONDED CALMLY TO QUESTIONS
 ABOUT THE ASSASSINATION.

HE ANSWERED A NUMBER OF TECHNICAL QUESTIONS ABOUT THE ASSASSINATION
 BY REFERRING TO THE CONCLUSIONS OF THE COMMISSION THAT BORE HIS
 NAME. HE SAID THE REPORT WAS "THE MOST WE COULD DO."

"WE COULD NOT DEAL WITH WHAT PEOPLE THINK, OR PEOPLE FEEL, OR
 PEOPLE BELIEVE," WARREN SAID IN EMPHASIZING THAT THE COMMISSION'S
 CONCLUSIONS WERE BASED ON STUDY OF ALL KNOWN FACTS ABOUT THE
 CRIME.
