 THE SUBPOENA, THE FIFTH ISSUED SINCE LAST TUESDAY, ORDERED J. B. Dauenhauer
 DAUENHAUER TO APPEAR AT GARRISON'S OFFICE AT 6 P.M. EST MONDAY.
 DAUENHAUER'S TRADE MART OFFICE SAID HE WAS OUT TO LUNCH AT THE
 TIME GARRISON ISSUED THE SUBPOENA.
 SO FAR THE ONLY ARREST IN THE CASE HAS BEEN THAT OF CLAY SHAW,
 FORMER MANAGING DIRECTOR OF THE TRADE MART.
 A TRADE MART RECEPTIONIST SAID SHE DID NOT KNOW DAUENHAUER'S
 TITLE AND SHE HAD BEEN INSTRUCTED TO SAY NOTHING.
 THE LOUISIANA ACLU SAID GARRISON'S HANDLING OF HIS PROBE "COULD
 QUITE POSSIBLY SERVE TO PROTECT THOSE GUILTY OF A CONSPIRACY" IF A
 GENUINE CASE EXISTS.
 UNDER THE HEADING "GARRISON GOOFS AGAIN," THE ACLU QUOTED THE
 LOUISIANA BAR ASSN.'S CANON 20: "NEWSPAPER PUBLICATIONS BY A
 LAWYER AS TO PENDING OR ANTICIPATED LITIGATION MAY INTERFERE WITH A FAIR
 TRIAL IN THE COURTS" AND "GENERALLY ARE TO BE CONDEMNED."
 GARRISON CONTENDS SHAW USED THE ALIAS "CLAY BERTRAND" IN
 CONSPIRING WITH LEE HARVEY OSWALD AND OTHERS IN 1963 TO KILL KENNEDY.
 SHAW WAS BOOKED FOR CONSPIRACY, BUT GARRISON USED LEGAL MOVES
 WHICH MADE IT UNNECESSARY TO FILE A FORMAL BILL OF INFORMATION
 CHARGING SHAW. A PRELIMINARY HEARING WAS SET FOR MARCH 14.
