WASHINGTON (UPI) --ATTY. GEN. RAMSEY CLARK SAID SUNDAY HE

"I THINK THIS IS SOMETHING FOR THE STATE, AND I HOPE THEY WILL PROCEED WITH DIGNITY," CLARK SAID ON A TELEVISION PROGRAM (FACE THE NATION--CBS).

HE DECLINED COMMENT ON THE CASE IN ADVANCE OF A COURT HEARING IN NEW ORLEANS TUESDAY TO ESTABLISH WHETHER GARRISON HAS SUFFICIENT EVIDENCE TO HOLD BUSINESSMAN CLAY SHAW. SHAW HAS BEEN BOOKED BUT NOT FORMALLY CHARGED WITH WHAT GARRISON SAYS IS A "CONSPIRACY TO MURDER JOHN F. KENNEDY."

CLARK SAID FEDERAL AUTHORITIES HAVE NOT ASKED GARRISON FOR EVIDENCE HE MAY HAVE IN THE CASE, "IN VIEW OF THE ATTITUDE HE HAS TAKEN."
