AUTHOR WILLIAM MANCHESTER WROTE IN "THE DEATH OF A PRESIDENT" THAT THE MAIN PEASON FOR KENNEDY'S TRIP WAS TO PATCH UP THE SPLIT IN THE IEXAS DEMOCRATIC PARTY.

ROWAN, A FORMER REPORTER FOR THE MINNEAPOLIS TRIBUNE, SAID IN THE ARTICLE, "THE LAST TIME I SAW JOHN F. KENNEDY HE WAS THE TARGET OF VIOLENT SUSPICIONS AND RAW HOSTILITY ON THE PART OF MILLIONS OF WHITE AMERICANS. WHO ARGUED THAT HE HAD GONE TOO FAR IN SUPPORT OF THE NEGRO." DANGEROUS FOR THIS COUNTRY. IT ENDANGERS YOU, ME AND HUMAN RIGHTS AND ALL THAT THIS ADMINISTRATION STANDS FOR.

"I HAVE MADE UP MY MIND THAT A PRESIDENT IS OBLIGATED TO USE THE PRESTICE OF HIS OFFICE TO TRY TO HALT THIS DAMMED MADNESS. I'M GOLING TO TEXAS TOMORROW BECAUSE I BELIEVE IT IS SOME THING I AM OBLIGATED TO DO."
