Two 'Plot' Figures Still Out of Jurisdiction

Martens Faces Assassination Jury

NEW ORLEANS, March 29 (UPI) — Layton Martens, detained by the FBI and the Secret Service three days after the assassination of President Kennedy, testifies today before a grand jury in Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison's investigation.

Mr. Martens, 24, has made statements contradicting information released in Mr. Garrison's probe of the assassination. E 2-14-63

FIRST HELD

Mr. Martens was arrested Nov. 25, 1963, at the apartment of David W. Ferrie along with Mr. Ferrie and Alvin Beauboeuf, following their trip to Brownsville, Tex. They had left New Orleans the day of the assassination.

New Orleans police records said all three were ordered held for the FBI and Secret Service for suspected "subversive activities" in connection with the assassination.

Mr. Martens said in a TV interview made public last week that he was a roommate of Mr. Ferrie's during mid-September 1963, when the alleged conspiracy against President Kennedy was being hatched. He said he never met any of the principals.

In Omaha, Neb., today, Mrs. Lillie Mae McMairnes, formerly known as Sandra Moffitt, was to tell a judge whether she would fight extradition back to Louisiana as a material witness.

NOVEL SOUGHT

Gordon Novel, 29, was the object of searches in Ohio, Virginia, Illinois, Missouri and possibly other states.

In another development last night, author Mark Lane, whose "Rush to Judgment" is a best seller, said after conferring with Mr. Garrison that Mr. Garrison would rock the nation when he disclosed his assassination case in a court trial. Mr. Lane also said Mr. Garrison would show there was more than one gunman in Dallas Nov. 22, 1963, and that Lee Harvey Oswald was not the one who fired the fatal shot.
