## Dallas Man Arrested in 8 Kennedy'Plot

DALLAS, Tex., (AP)-Detectives have arrested Sergio Vincente Arcacha Smith, 44, at his home here on a warrant from Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison of New Orleans.

The warrant said Arcacha, David Ferrie and Gordon Novel worked together in a burglary attempt at a munitions bunker.

Ferrie died of natural causes Feb. 22, said a New Orleans coroner, but Garrison says it was suicide and the dead pilot figured in his investigation of ingured in his investigation of what he says was a plot to kill President John F. Kennedy. Novel is in a Columbus, Ohio, jail after failing to post a \$10,000 bond in an extradition fight.

Police took Arcacha, a former anti-castro leader, to the Dallas County Jail after his arrest vesterday.

Dallas Dist. Atty. Bill Alexander had advised Arcacha not to return to New Orleans unless

subpoenaed.

In New Orleans, Dist. Judge
Edward A. Haggerty Jr. has
banned all persons officially
connected with the assassination conspiracy trial of Clay L. Shaw from talking about the case, UPI said.

Shaw, former managing director of the New Orleans International trade mart, is scheduled to be arraigned tomorrow on Garrison's charge of conspiring to assassinate Kennedy in 1963.
