Garrison Witness Must Face Court

A hearing on the removal of Mrs. Lillie McMaines to New Orleans, La., to testify be-fore a grand jury was requested Wednesday in Douglas County District Court.

An application filed by Chief Deputy County Attorney Arthur O'Leary requested that Mrs. McManies be asked to show cause why she should not return to New Orleans.

The petition came after County Attorney Donald Knowles received formal papers from Orleans Parish (County) certifying that Mrs. McMaines was a material witness wanted in an investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy.

The Louisiana papers also asked that Mrs. McMaines be granted "protection from arrest or the service of process, civil or criminal" in connection with matters that arise prior to her entering Louisiana for the grand jury, in session beginning next Tuesday.

According to the Louisiana documents, Mrs. McMaines publicly admitted knowing Perry Raymond Russo and was present in the home of David W. Ferrie in New Orleans on the night when an alleged conspiracy to kill President Kennedy was overheard. She has denied being at the party that night.

The mail from Louisiana included a check

for 246 dollars to cover her expenses.

Mr. Knowles said he had asked Mrs. Mc-Maines's bail bondsman to bring her to the Courthouse.

Earlier, Mrs. McMaines had been arrested as a "fugitive from justice" and released on one thousand dollars bond. She is to appear in District Court on that matter April 25.
