# JFK Death Study Hit

The American people will be shocked as they have never been shocked before when they learn the truth about who killed President Kennedy, said Mark Lane, a critic of the Warren Commission Report, who spoke Wednesday afternoon before about 2,000 students at Michigan State University.

Lane, who was counsel for Lee Harvey Oswald, accused assassin of the President, before the Warren Commission, said that the commission was unwilling to tell the American people the facts about Kennedy's murder.

Lane defended District Attorney Garrison of New Orleans who said that in a forthcoming trial he will prove who really killed JFK.

### DEATH THREATS

Describing Garrison as "a real intellectual," Lane said the district attorney had taken him into his confidence and therefore he can not reveal the murderers.

"But I can tell you this," he said. "That a powerful, domestic American force — an anti-Castro force that is still an influence — was involved in the plot to kill the president."

He has received more than 100 death threats, Lane said, and now the heat is on Garrison, who also is receiving threats.

Lane said that he had approached 15 leading U.S. publishers about printing his book, "Rush To Judgment," which "exposes time and again the incorrect, even stupid conclusions of the Warren Commission."

All publishers, at first, agreed to print his book and all later changed their minds.

Finally a publisher in England agreed to do so, after which a firm he had not contacted in the

U.S. said they would publish it. "Rush To Judgment" has become a best seller.

Lane described his harassment by the FBI and said that it was a highly placed official of the organization who tried to stop publication of his book by the publisher who finally did bring it out.

The speaker prefaced his shocking statements by telling his audience with point after point about the laws of ballistics and the paths of a bullet which struck Kennedy.

With biting, sarcastic humor which drew many laughs from the audience in the university's main auditorium, Lane explained how one bullet — if a Warren Commission is true — "must have hung in the air about 1½ seconds" after it struck Kennedy and before it struck Gov. Connally of Texas.
