COLUMBUS, OHIO--GOV. JAMES A. RHODES TODAY RETURNED UNSIGNED THE EXTRADITION PAPERS OF GORDON NOVEL, WANTED IN THE NEW ORLEANS INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED KENNEDY ASSASSINATION PLOT.

PHODES ASKED THAT SEVERAL TECHNICAL POINTS IN THE PAPERS BE CLEARED UP. JOHN MCELROY, AN AIDE TO THE GOVERNOR, SAID THIS WAS NOT UNUSUAL.

MEANWHILE, NOVEL'S ATTORNEY SAID THE FORMER NIGHTCLUB OPERATOR WILL "GO INTO DETAIL" MONDAY IN AN EFFORT TO BACK UP HIS CHARGES AGAINST NEW ORLEANS DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON WHO IS CONDUCTING THE INVESTIGATION.
