(KENNEDY ASSASSINATION)

WASHINGTON--THE FBI REMAINED CLOSED-MOUTHED TODAY ABOUT A PUERTO RICAN WHO THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION (NBI) SAYS CLAIMED UNDER TRUTH SERUM HE TOOK PART IN AN ASSASSINATION PLOT AGAINST PRESIDENT KENNEDY.

"WE HAVE NOTHING TO SAY," AN FBI SPOKESMAN SAID. "ABSOLUTELY NOTHING AT ALL."

AN NBI INVESTIGATION REPORT SHOWN TO NEWSMEN YESTERDAY STATED THAT LUIS ANGEL CASTILLO, 24, ADMITTED THAT HE WAS IN DALLAS AT THE TIME OF THE ASSASSINATION AND HAD BEEN GIVEN A RIFLE BY AN UNIDENTIFIED MAN AND TOLD TO SHOOT "A MAN IN AN OPEN CAR" DURING A MOTORCADE.

THE FBI SPOKESMAN SAID THE FEDERAL BUREAU'S OFFICIAL POLICY IS TO REFUSE TO COMMENT ABOUT "ALL THESE BIZARRE PLOT REPORTS."

ACCORDING TO THE PHILIPPINE REPORT, CASTILLO SAID THERE WERE ABOUT 15 OTHER PLOTTERS STATIONED ALONG THE MOTORCADE ROUTE.
