"THE PLAN TO SOME EXTENT WAS SHOOTING AN ATROPHINE DART INTO THE UNSUSPECTING FERRIE, TAKING HIM TO A SECRET PLACE, GIVING HIM SODIUM PENTATHOL, AND OTHERWISE ABUSING HIM UNTIL HE CONFESSED, ACCORDING TO A TRANSCRIPT OF A LIE DETECTOR TEST GIVEN NOVEL.

NOVEL AND HIS ATTORNEY, JERRY WEINER, HELD A PRESS CONFERENCE TODAY TO RELEASE RESULTS OF TESTS GIVEN NOVEL, WANTED AS A MATERIAL WITNESS IN THE INVESTIGATION, LAST MARCH 25.

WEINER CHALLENGED GARRISON TO TAKE A SIMILAR TEST.

"BASED ON THE RESULTS OF ALL THE TESTS, IT IS MY OPINION MR. NOVEL IS TELLING THE TRUTH, WEINER SAID. "THE ONLY WAY ANYONE CAN EVER DISPEL DOUBTS RAISED BY MR. NOVEL IS BY MR. GARRISON'S TAKING THE SAME TESTS."

NOVEL, 29, CHARGED GARRISON'S PROBE WAS A "FRAUD" MOTIVATED BY THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S POLITICAL AMBITIONS.

NOVEL SAID HE WORKED FOR GARRISON FOR ABOUT TWO WEEKS BEFORE HE BEGAN TO HAVE DOUBTS ABOUT THE INVESTIGATION. NOVEL LATER FLED NEW ORLEANS AND TURNED UP IN COLUMBUS, OHIO. HE IS FIGHTING EXTRADITION. TO NEW ORLEANS. NOVEL TOLD NEWSMEN THAT AT A MEETING WITH GARRISON FEB. 21. HE AGREED TO ORDER THE DART GUN AND DART NEEDED TO TRAP FERRIE BUT THE PLAN WAS NEVER CARRIED OUT BECAUSE FERRIE, A PILOT FROM CLEVELAND, OHIO, WAS FOUND DEAD THE NEXT DAY.

DR. WILLIS DRISCOLL, A COLUMBUS PSYCHOLOGIST PRESENT AT THE NEWS CONFERENCE, SAID:

"WE HAVEN'T HAD TIME TO FORM A PROFESSIONAL OPINION YET AS TO THE VALIBITY (OF THE TESTS GIVEN NOVEL) BUT THERE SEEMS TO BE NO MAJOR INCONSISTENCIES BETWEEN ANY OF THE TESTS."
