(KENNEDY ASSASSINATION)

NEW ORLEANS--JULIUS OSWALD, ONE OF THE FOUR OSWALDS WHOSE NAMES HAVE COME UP IN DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON'S INVESTIGATION OF THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION, WAS QUESTIONED BY GARRISON'S OFFICE THURSDAY.

OSWALD, WHO WORKED IN THE SAME COFFEE PLANT AS LEE HARVEY OSWALD, REFUSED TO TALK TO NEWSMEN AS HE ARRIVED. HE SLIPPED OUT A BACK DOOR AS HE LEFT.

THE FOUR OSWALDS ARE JULIUS, WILLIAM, AN UNCLE OF WILLIAM'S WITH THE SAME NAME, AND LEE HARVEY, NAMED BY THE WARREN COMMISSION AS THE ASSASSIN OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. ~~63, 386~~ KENNEDY

BOTH JULIUS AND THE YOUNGER WILLIAM OSWALD WERE QUESTIONED THIS WEEK. IT WAS NOT KNOWN IF THEY WERE RELATED TO LEE HARVEY OSWALD, ALTHOUGH WILLIAM, QUESTIONED BY NEWSMEN, WOULD NOT CONFIRM OR DENY IT.

WILLIAM OSWALD, OF METAIRIE, LA., WAS ALSO SUBPOENAED THIS WEEK, AND WAS QUESTIONED WEDNESDAY.

HE TOLD NEWSMEN HE DID NOT KNOW LEE HARVEY OSWALD, WHO ONCE PUT DOWN "WILLIAM OSWALD" AS A REFERENCE ON AN EMPLOYMENT APPLICATION FOR THE STANDARD COFFEE CO., WHERE HE WORKED. OSWALD SAID HE THOUGHT THIS REFERRED TO THE OTHER WILLIAM OSWALD, AN UNCLE.

JULIUS OSWALD ALSO WORKED FOR STANDARD. NEITHER JULIUS OR THE TWO WILLIAM OSWALDS ARE MENTIONED IN THE WARREN COMMISSION REPORT.
