Shaw Asks Quashing

NEW ORLEANS—Clay L. Shaw asked the Criminal District Court here to quash the charge by District Attorney Jim Garrison that he

conspired to assassinate President Kennedy.

Attorneys for the 54-year-old retired businessman said in their plea that the indictment was "so vague and indefinite" that the defendant could not properly prepare a defense. They also contend that the indictment was worthless because it was based "solely or primarily on the testimony of one Perry Russo, whose testimony was not valid, proper or legal for the reason that it was the product of post-hypnotic suggestion.

The New Orleans States-Item said Garrison will seek to show that Lee Harvey Oswald, with whom Garrison is accused of conspiring, was an undercover agent who aided the cause of anti-Castro Cubans here.
