(KENNEDY ASSASSINATION)
NEW ORLEANS--DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON'S ASSASSINATION INVESTIGATION
REACHED INTO FEDERAL RANKS TODAY WITH GRAND JURY SUBPOENAS ISSUED
FOR AN FBI AGENT AND A FORMER FBI AGENT.
SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES SERVED A SUBPOENA YESTERDAY ON FBI AGENT
REGIS KENNEDY IN HIS FEDERAL BUILDING OFFICE. DEPUTIES SAID THE FBI
TOLD THEM WARREN DEBRUEYS HAD BEEN TRANSFERRED TO WASHINGTON.
DEBRUEYS REPORTEDLY WORKED WITH AGENT KENNEDY IN THE NEW
ORLEANS INVESTIGATION OF THE ASSASSINATION IN 1963 AND EARLY
1964.

THE SECOND SUBPOENA ALSO CARRIED A FEDERAL BUILDING ADDRESS
AS WELL AS ONE FOR THE EASTERN SECTION OF THE CITY. DEBRUEYS WAS
NOT LOCATED AT EITHER ADDRESS. THE CITY DIRECTORY LISTS THE
WARREN DEBRUEYS AT THE EASTSIDE ADDRESS AS AN ENGINEER FOR THE
COEING COMPANY.

THE LOCAL OFFICE OF THE FBI WOULD NOT COMMENT ON THE SUBPOENAS,
WHICH INSTRUCT THE MEN TO APPEAR BEFORE THE GRAND JURY NEXT
WEDNESDAY.

A COPYRIGHTED STORY IN THE NEW ORLEANS STATES-ITEM FRIDAY SAID
GARRISON IS TRYING TO LINK LEE HARVEY OSWALD TO THE CAUSE OF
ANTI-COMMUNIST CURANS AS AN OPERATIVE OF THE CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE
AGENCY.

THE NEWSPAPER QUOTED "INFORMED SOURCES" WHICH SAID GARRISON'S
INVESTIGATION WAS A DIRECT CHALLENGE TO THE WARREN COMMISSION
FINDINGS AND SAID IT WAS MOVING CLOSER TO LINKING THE CIA TO A
NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS UNDER INVESTIGATION.

DURING THE WARREN COMMISSION'S INVESTIGATION, JOHN A. MCCONE,
THEN DIRECTOR OF THE CIA, AND RICHARD HELMS, THE CURRENT DIRECTOR,
TESTIFIED BEFORE THE COMMISSION THAT OSWALD HAD NEVER BEEN
CONNECTED WITH THE TOP SECRET AGENCY.
