LEXINGTON, MASS.-LITEK CORP. SAID TODAY MILLIONTHS OF AN INCH
MEASUREMENTS WERE MADE IN ITS ANALYSIS OF THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION FILM.

HOWARD SPRAGUE, ASSISTANT TO THE PRESIDENT, TOLD A NEWS CONFERENCE THAT SOME 30 PERSONS SPENT ALMOST TWO MONTHS ANALYZING THE FILM TO SOLVE THE QUESTION OF A "FIGURE" SOME PERSONS THOUGHT THEY SAW IN THE MOVIE AND BELIEVED TO BE A SECOND GUNMAN.

BY MAKING THREE-DIMENSIONAL IMAGES, THE RESEARCHERS DETERMINED THE FIGURE WAS NOTHING BUT A SHADOW, THUS DEMOLISHING AN ASSASSINATION THEORY OPPOSED TO THE WARREN COMMISSION REPORT.

SPRAGUE SAID STUDY SHOWED NO CONTRADICTIONS TO WHAT THE WARREN COMMISSION REPORT SAID ABOUT THE "FIGURE."

IT WAS POSSIBLE TO CONSTRUCT THREE-DIMENSIONAL IMAGES BECAUSE TWO SEGMENTS OF THE FILM WERE TAKEN FROM POINTS 18 FEET APART.

THE FILM INVOLVED WAS OWNED BY UPI AND TAKEN BY AN AMATEUR PHOTOGRAPHER, ORILLE NIX.
